

Geneco Jay Chou 2022 x for Plant-A-Tree Donation Terms & Conditions

A. Official Rules

1. The Geneco Jay Chou 2022 x Plant-A-Tree Donation (the “**Donation**”) is organised by Geneco (“**Geneco**”) by Seraya Energy, a subsidiary of YTL PowerSeraya Pte Limited (the “**Organiser**”). Participants should note that the terms “Geneco” and “Organiser” will be used interchangeably in the course of this Donation and shall be taken to have the one and the same meaning.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to change any terms and conditions of the Donation at its sole and absolute discretion, without prior notice, reason or liability. By entering the Donation, the Participants not only undertake to review the Terms and Conditions of the Donation at any particular time, which has been made available for public viewing at the Geneco’s Donation page <https://www.giving.sg/garden-city-fund/genecoptc22> but also agree to be bound to subsequent new or amended Terms and Conditions (if any).
3. The Organiser also reserves the right to terminate, cancel, suspend or amend (including but not limited to replacing the Donation’s prize with one or more items of similar value) the Donation at any time without prior notice, reason or liability. The Organiser accepts no responsibility and/or liability for any deviation in the prize values (if any).

B. Eligibility Conditions

4. Subject to the provisions of these Terms and Conditions, this Donation is only open to participants who satisfy the following conditions within the Donation Period:
 - (a) Are and/or are above the age of eighteen (18) years;
 - (b) Currently reside in Singapore at a permanent residential address; and
 - (c) Top five who have made the highest donation amount to the Geneco x Garden City Fund’s Plant-A-Tree Programme via <https://www.giving.sg/garden-city-fund/genecoptc22>.
5. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Donation is not open to both employees of Seraya Energy Pte Ltd, YTL PowerSeraya Pte Limited or PetroSeraya Pte Ltd and their immediate family members (such as their spouse, children, siblings and parents). The Donation is also not open

to any other participant deemed ineligible and/or notified by the Organiser as being ineligible at any point during the course of the Donation.

C. *Donation Period*

6. The Donation period shall begin on 1 August 2022 at 9am and end on 31 August 2022 at 11:59pm (the "Donation Period"). The Organiser reserves their right to amend the Donation Period at any time without prior notice.

D. *Selection of Winners, Prizes and Notifications*

7. There will be five (5) winners selected by the Organiser for this Donation. Each winner will be entitled to a pair of Cat 5 tickets to Jay Chou Carnival World Tour - Singapore concert 2022 worth \$436 ("Prize"), which will be held on 17 December 2022.
8. The Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash, any other forms of credit, and/or any other goods or services, and is subject to such other terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Organiser.
9. The Prizes cannot be resold or offered for resale, or else SportsHub will void the tickets.
10. The results of the Donation shall be final and binding, and no appeal against the Donation's results shall be entertained. In the event of any dispute, the Organiser's decision shall be final and no further correspondence will be entertained.
11. The Organiser shall announce the winners of the Donation at the end of October 2022 via Electronic Direct Mailer ("eDM") to the winner's email address registered under the winner's Geneco account with methods for the Prize redemption. The winners must follow the redemption process provided in the eDM to redeem the Prize. Failure of the winner in complying with the redemption process may result in a delay in the receipt and/or disbursement of the Prize to the winner's Geneco residential electricity account.
12. The winner must redeem the Prize within 14 calendar days from the date of receipt of the eDM ("Redemption Period"). Failure of the winner to redeem the Prize within the Redemption Period will render the Prize as forfeited and unaccepted. The Organiser will not be responsible and/or

will not entertain any request or appeal for the failure of any winner to redeem their Prize within the Redemption Period.

13. Attendees have to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and will be required to show valid proof of vaccination as a condition of entry into the venue. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated will be denied entry (with or without a valid Pre-Event Test).

E. *Disclaimer*

14. Should any of the Terms and Conditions stated herein be held illegal or unenforceable, such term or provision shall be deemed to be deleted from the Terms and Conditions of the Donation. The rest of the Terms and Conditions shall remain in full force and effect. Failure by the Organiser to exercise any of its rights as stated in the Terms and Conditions herein does not and should not constitute a waiver of those rights.
15. Should there be any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any advertising, promotional, publicity and other materials relating to or in connection with this Donation, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

F. *Use of information and publicity*

16. Participants are deemed to have provided consent to the Organiser and its affiliates, pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act 2012, for the collection, storage, use and disclosure of their personal data for the purposes of administering and accessing this Donation.

G. *Limitations and Indemnity*

17. Participants shall assume all risk in respect of loss, injury, damage or liability which may arise as a result of or in connection with the participant's participation in the Donation.

H. *Governing Law and Jurisdiction*

18. The Donation and the Terms and Conditions associated therewith shall be governed by Singapore law. By participating in the Donation, each participant agrees to submit to the

exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Republic of Singapore insofar as the subject relates to the Donation and Terms and Conditions associated therewith.

19. For the avoidance of doubt, a person who is not a party to any agreement governed by these Terms and Conditions shall have no right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act (Cap. 53B) to enforce any terms of such agreement.
